NAPLAN tests skills that are essential for every child to progress through school and life, such as reading, writing, spelling and numeracy. The assessments are undertaken nationwide, every year, in the second full week in May.

NAPLAN is made up of tests in the four areas of:

- reading
- writing
- language conventions (spelling, grammar and punctuation)
- numeracy

MOVING FORWARD AIMING HIGH

Learning Environment: Leader: Martine Logue

This committee is working on Improvement strategies 5 and 6. These include instilling a culture of high expectations in the school, as well as strengthening the alignment between having a safe and orderly school environment and nurturing student academic success.

To achieve this, the committee have reviewed the Communication: Student at Education Risk; Attendance and Behaviour Policies in the school. They also reviewed our Individual Education Plan and Behaviour Plan templates to ensure that processes and timelines are in place and adhered to. They have also focussed on the Virtues program and planning for this in our Strategic Plan.

The committee has also focussed on the English as a Second Language Students. In 2016 an action plan was created to ensure these students are catered for. Last year Denisse Scassera was our EAL/D co-ordinator, and this year Donna Reid has picked up the portfolio. The teachers have completed professional learning about Cultural Awareness as well as working with the Progress Maps for the learning programs for the students.

The committee was involved with getting the Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) Framework into the school. The PBS leadership committee have taken over the role of the Learning Environment committee

The official launch for the Entertainment Book is Friday 5 May. Any early birds that purchase before then will receive additional vouchers available to use straight away.

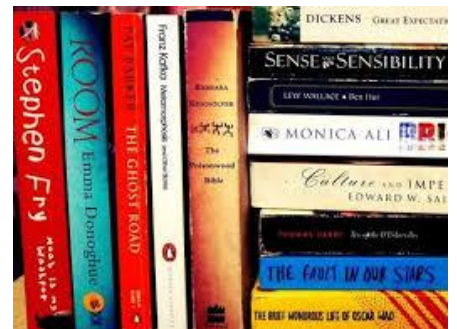
School Fete

Are you a parent that works from home?

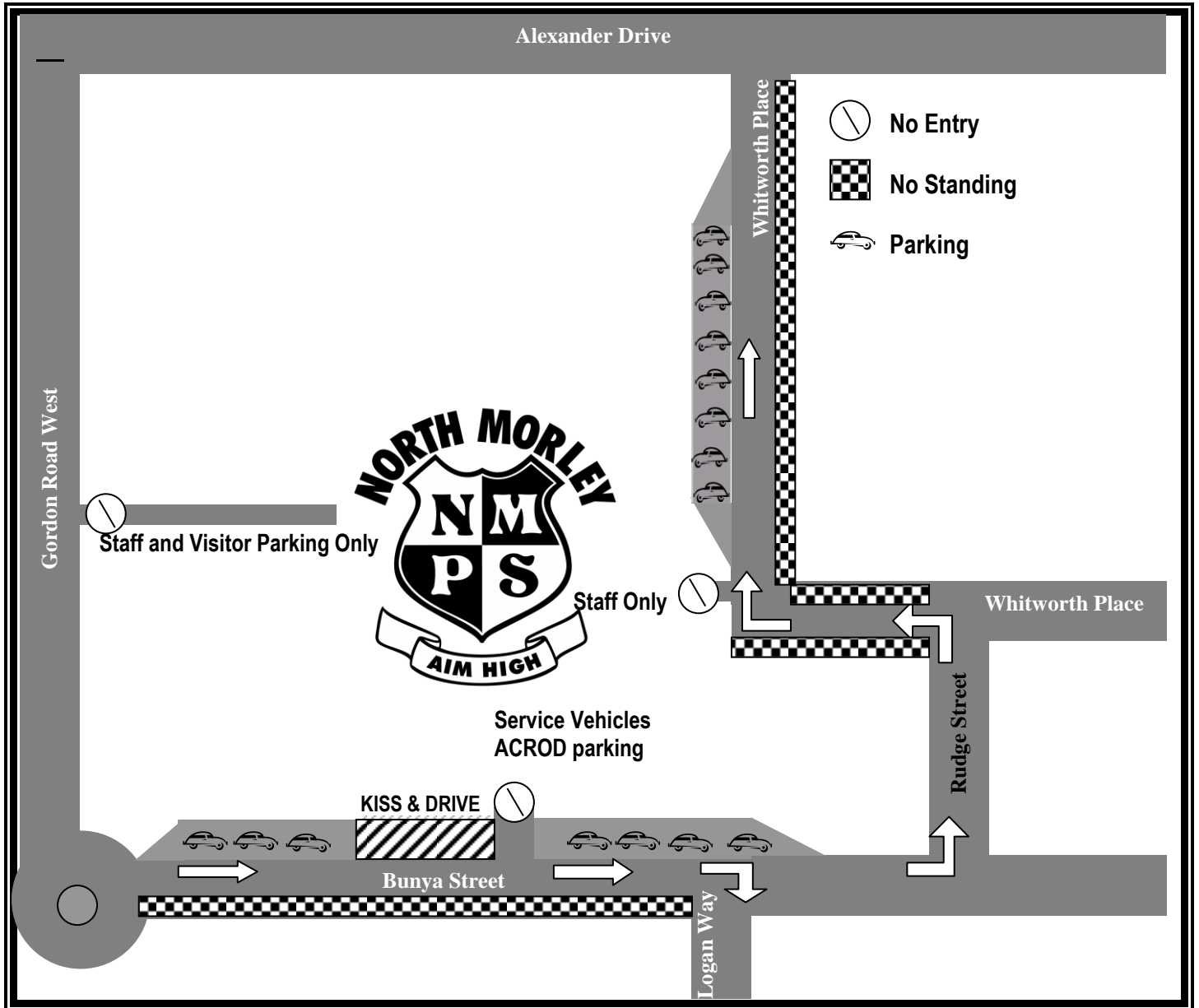
Have you got a special skill/qualification?
