## MOVING FORWARD AIMING HIGH

During our School Development Day, the staff participated in a workshop run by the PBS team. This is our 3<sup>rd</sup> workshop since starting our PBS journey late last year. Our goal was to draft a behavioural matrix plan using our acronym, SPORT, along with our established five school settings. The different school settings are:

1. In Class
2. Playground
3. Moving Around the School
4. Specialist Classes
5. Before and After School

By the end of this term the PBS team will design a matrix draft based on the ideas staff stated at the workshop.

The school community was consulted (Student Councillors, School Council, P&C, Gardener, Cleaners, Parents, Students, All staff) in establishing the desired behaviours we wish to see at North Morley Primary School and they had opportunities to participate in the voting. The top five behaviours were selected and used to start our matrix planning off.

For new families to our school, PBS stands for Positive Behaviour Support and SPORT is an acronym for Safe, Positive, Organised, Respectful and Tolerant. Our catch phrase will become "I'm A Good Sport In Everything I Do".

Behaviour education is empowered when it is explicitly taught and integrated; just like subject areas are taught and integrated across the curriculum.

## Great Fun in After School Care with Camp Australia

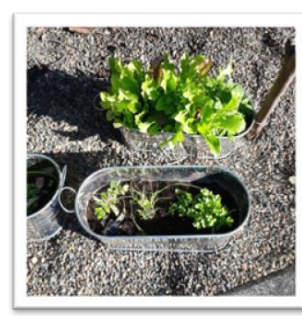
Welcome back to Term 3 – we hope you enjoyed your school holidays!
