### **Moving Forward Aiming High**

Last week our ERG committee leaders and I attended a two day professional learning course titled “Leading a Culture of Classroom Observation and Feedback”.

The course was designed around extensive international and national research which showed that the highest performing teachers are those from schools that value and provide time for teachers to be observed in their classrooms and receive constructive feedback. Feedback is best when there is time for self-reflection as well as post observation professional discussions.

Observations will be largely peer based; that is teachers observing teachers. There is also an added benefit of two ways learning with this method.

Our Culture of Classroom Observation (CCO) team will begin to work on devising a timeline for implementation of this programme; incorporating the development of protocols (including teachers choosing the purpose for each observation - e.g. questioning levels/type/techniques). The CCO team will then trial some classroom observations with one another before sharing, presenting and supporting staff on their own journeys towards the end of this year and in 2018.
