STEP 1

Choose your old t-shirt. Cut the sleeves off. Cut the neckline area.



STEP 2

Turn the shirt inside out. Mark how deep you want the bag. Cut a fringe (cut the front and back layer together).



STEP 3

Tie back and front fringe together in a pair. Then take the front of one pair and the back of neighbouring pair and tie. Turn the shirt right side out and admire!

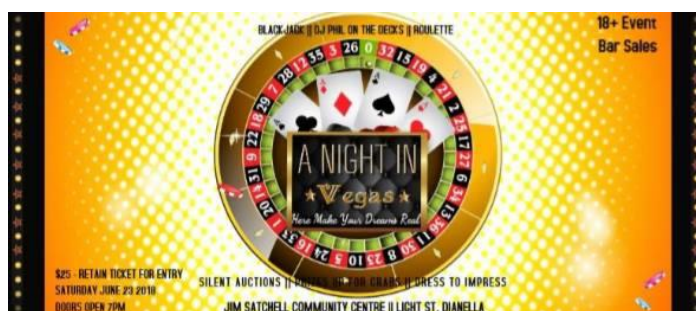
