School Enrolments 2019

Friday 20 July is an important date in your child's education

Families need to apply to enrol their children in a public school for 2019 if they are:

- starting Kindergarten – 4 years old by 30 June 2019
- starting Pre-primary (first year of compulsory school) – 5 years old by 30 June 2019
- starting Year 7 (first year of secondary school)
- changing schools.

All children from Pre-primary to Year 12 are guaranteed a place at their local public school.

To apply to enrol your child, visit your local school by Friday 20 July 2018.
