Lost Property

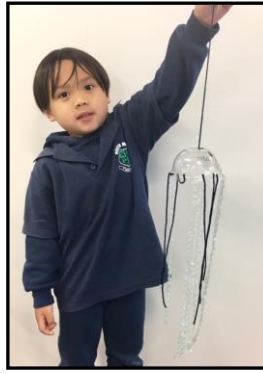
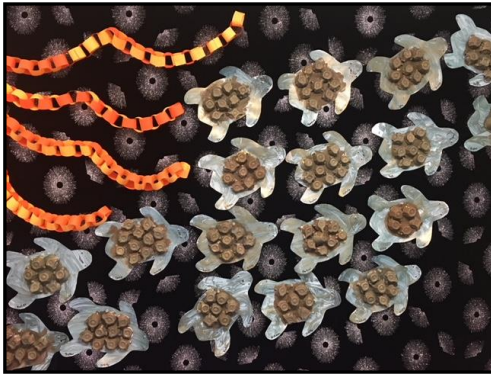
The lost property is overflowing once again. If your child has lost something at school please check the lost property located in the After School Care wet area. Any items without names on them will be disposed of next term.

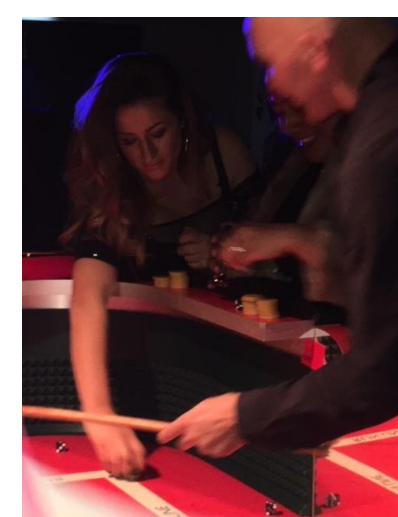
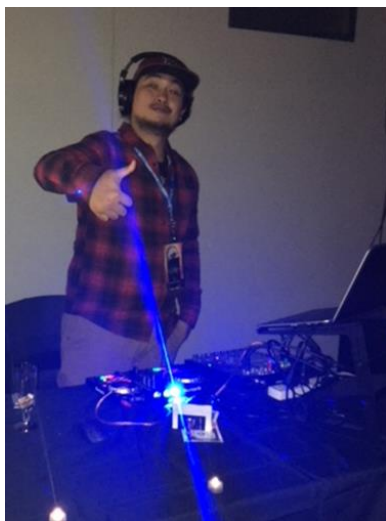
Nature Play Areas
