At a recent conference I won a year's subscription for our school to ParentTV. We have now signed up to Parent TV on behalf of all our parents and staff, which we are very excited about. Parent TV is an on-demand video streaming website for parents delivering the help they need from trusted experts anytime of the day or night. Experts include a paediatrician, occupational therapists, psychiatrist, psychologist, accredited practising dietician, autism consultant, behaviour therapist, sleep consultant, technology expert, social worker, health and wellness expert and counsellor with new experts coming on every month.

Each parent will be able to create their own personal account which allows them to create profiles for each of their children with their age, gender and any specific concerns you may have. The website then shows you the content most relevant to each of your children based on your preferences and their profile.

Tennis Lessons at NMPS
