Welcome from the Principal

Welcome to week 6 of this term. Our fence is almost finished and is looking amazing. Please be aware that when the fence is completed, the Whitworth lace and Gordon Road West gates will be locked from **9:00am** and you will need to enter the school from Bunya Street entrance.

As we head into Phase 3 of the WA government's plan, beginning on June 6, more facilities are opening in the community. Playgrounds will be open for use. Also parents/carers are able to enter the school grounds to drop off/pick up their children only. Volunteering and class assistance is not able to begin yet.

It has been terrific to see the independence that has developed in our students over this term. They are now in the routine of independently preparing for the school day. We would like to continue this growth, and ask that, if it is not essential for you to take your child to the undercover area, please continue to drop off/pick up from Bunya Street or Whitworth Place.

In the mornings, students will continue to assemble in the undercover area in their class groups. Teachers will continue to pick up the students from this area when the first siren sounds. Afternoon pick-ups will continue as it has been operating this term.

Pre-primary students will continue to be dropped off/ picked up at the gate near the oval, as they have done for this term.

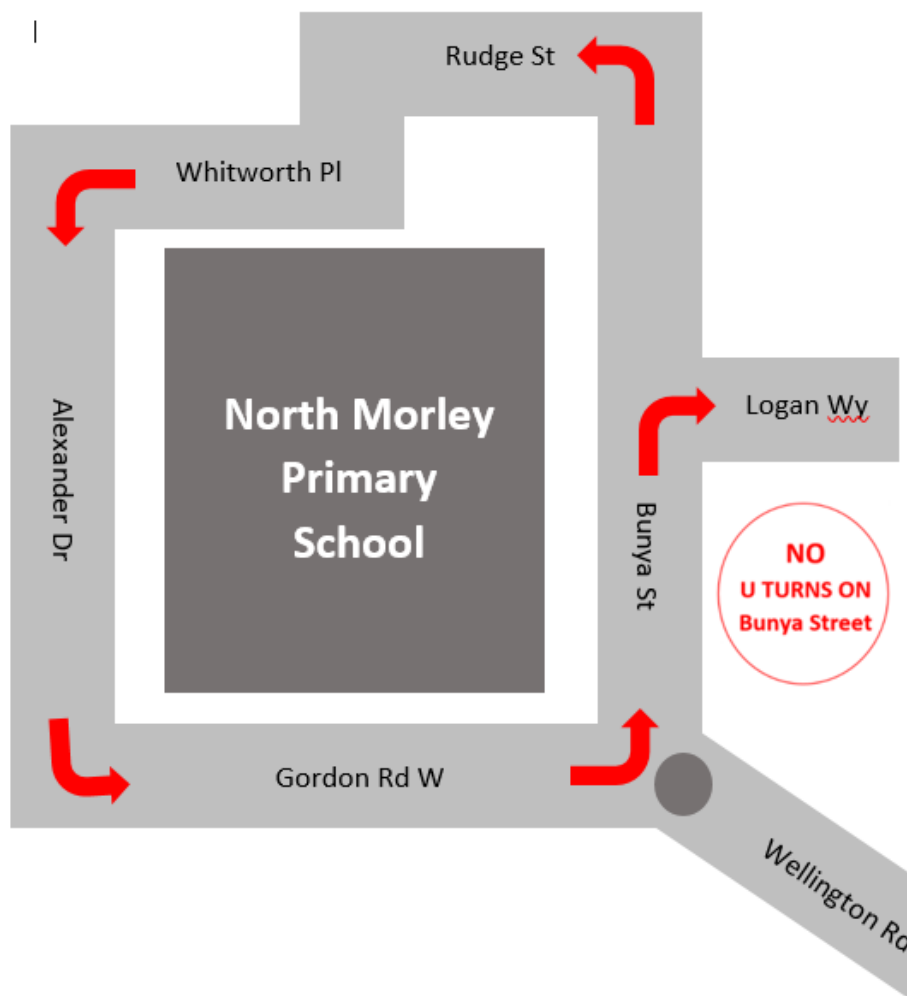
Kindy students, as of next week, will need to assemble in the undercover area and will be taken to class by Mrs Rinaldi or Mrs Cugley.
